IOB development will include determining detailed elements of cost for regular pay, overtime, cash awards, travel, transportation, rents, communications and utilities, printing, contracts, supplies, equipment, land/structures, interest, depreciation and other gains and losses. Skill is required in the application of methods and techniques to illustrate meaningful data for analyzing and evaluating; interpret and apply accounting concepts and determining whether cost information is reasonable. Excel and/or spreadsheet knowledge is required. Access and/or database knowledge is a plus.
